



eCampus/Blackboard Training

Online Certification Courses

Faculty new to the colleges of DCCCD are required to complete eCampus Certification Training in order to use our Blackboard (eCampus) Learning Management System. There are two online certification options.

XDLP-2001: eCampus Online Training and Assessments

Faculty teaching online and/or hybrid classes need to successfully complete this course/certification. Faculty that only teach face-to-face classes can also complete this certification. This certification covers 4 areas of eCampus:

- BT 101 - eCampus Basics,
- BT 102 - Assessments and Surveys,
- BT 103 - The Grade Center and
- BT 104 - Communication Tools.

XDLP-2003: eCampus Face-To-Face Certification

This course/certification is for faculty that only teach face-to-face classes. This certification covers:

- BT 101 - eCampus Basics and
- BT 103 - The Grade Center.

Note: Faculty must complete a certification class and pass the class assessment(s) in one semester.

eCampus Face-to-Face Training

The online certification courses include eCampus training materials. However, the Software Training and Support department does offer face-to-face eCampus training sessions:

- BT 101 - eCampus Basics,
- BT 102 - Assessments and Surveys,
- BT 103 - The Grade Center and
- BT 104 - Communication Tools.

Note: Faculty taking face-to-face trainings still need to register for and successfully complete **XDLP 2003** (or XDLP 2001 if they will only be teaching face-to-face classes) in order to receive the required eCampus certification.
